Construction Updates

We would like to inform our residents of some important updates regarding the construction progress at 235 Balliol Street. Underpinning work and dewatering will continue as part of our ongoing efforts.

Please note that the construction of 235 Balliol Street is expected to take roughly three years to complete. Construction activities will adhere to all mandatory bylaws as established by the City of Toronto.

Smart Parcel Locker System

We have recently rolled out a new security system to facilitate secure and contactless parcel deliveries. Smart parcel lockers have been installed in the ground floor lobby at 221 Balliol Street for a streamlined parcel handling experience.

Now when your parcels are deposited you'll receive a text message (or email for those without a mobile number on file) from our service provider, Snaile. This notification will include a unique, one-time PIN code and QR code for convenient and secure parcel collection at your convenience.



In case of oversized parcels, the delivery companies were informed by the smart locker service provider to deliver the parcels in front of the suite doors and they were also advised through signs posted in the smart locker area. Since there are some cases of non-compliance,



please check the lobby and lounge area if you are expecting large parcels.

- Foam / Wire wreath form

- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- Ribbon for hanging

GLUE the ornaments to the wreath form, spacing them evenly.

ATTACH a ribbon to the top with hot glue, creating a loop for hanging.

CONTINUE until the entire wreath form is covered. Be creative with the arrangement and mix up colors and sizes for a dynamic look.

CREATE layers to add depth, glue some ornaments on top of others.

DRY completely before hanging it on your door.
