Scheduled Work and Parking

With the preparatory work nearing completion, we're gearing up for the exciting transition into the construction of the new tower. During this period, we will provide alternative parking spaces to accommodate all affected spaces.

In our ongoing commitment to your convenience, we have secured alternative parking spaces even closer than originally planned. As we transition into the construction phase, starting in **early December 2023**, residents with vehicles affected by construction activities will be temporarily relocated to a secure offsite parking lot conveniently located at **3100 Cawthra Road**, **Mississauga**, for an estimated duration of 39 months.

To make your commuting experience hassle-free, Park Property Management will arrange shuttle services through a trusted third party between 600 & 620 Lolita Gardens and the offsite parking location at 3100 Cawthra Road. These shuttle services will be available 24/7 throughout the entire



construction period.

Completed Balcony Renovations

We're pleased to announce the successful completion of balcony renovations at 600 Lolita Gardens. As a part of this enhancement, pigeon netting has been installed, ensuring the comfort and well-being of all residents.

Environmental Preservation Efforts

In our commitment to preserving the environment, the installation of tree protection hoarding has been successfully completed. The hoarding has been put in place to safeguard the trees on the property during the construction process.
