Maple syrup, primarily sourced from Canada, is one of the few food products entirely produced in North America. It takes approximately 40 gallons of maple sap to yield just 1 gallon of this sweet syrup!

Featured Recipe: Mango Salsa



As we welcome the warmer weather, why not add a burst of flavor to your meals with this refreshing Mango Salsa recipe? It's perfect for dipping with tortilla chips or as a topping for grilled fish or chicken!

What you will need:

- · 2 ripe mangoes, diced
- 1/2 red onion, finely chopped
- 1 red bell pepper, diced
- 1/2 jalapeño pepper, seeded and finely chopped
- 1/4 cup fresh cilantro, chopped
- Juice of 1 lime
- Salt and pepper

MIX the diced mangoes, red onion, red bell pepper, jalapeño pepper, and cilantro in a bowl

SQUEEZE the lime juice over the mixture

ADD salt and pepper to taste

USE craft glue or a hot glue gun to secure the decorations in place.

SERVE immediately or refrigerate for at least 30 mins to allow the flavors to meld
