Along the western perimeter, the tiebacks have been successfully installed adjacent to the neighbouring property. Excavation efforts have yielded substantial depth. Additionally, the necessary wells behind the soldier piles have been completed.

Featured Recipe: Strawberry Rice Krispies Treats

- 4 cups mini marshmallows
- 5 cups Rice Krispies cereal
- 1/4 cup unsalted butter
- Pink food coloring
- Cherry blossom sprinkles or edible
 flowers

MELT the butter over low heat in a large saucepan

ADD a few drops of pink food coloring

REMOVE it from the heat and quickly stir in the Rice Krispies cereal

PRESS mixture into a baking dish

DECORATE with cherry blossom sprinkles

ALLOW it to cool for about 30 minutes and cut into squares
