Construction Updates

Construction is progressing well. We've completed 85% of the shoring operations and about 70% of the excavation. Temporary power will be set up by Toronto Hydro this month, and we're planning to install the

crane in December 2024.

Parking Instructions

To better accommodate everyone's parking needs, we kindly ask that you display your original parking pass or accessibility permit clearly on your dashboard for easy visibility. Unfortunately, visitors cannot park around the building or in your assigned spot. Please remember to request a Dundas pass from our Resident Relations Representative in the Rental Office for your visitors in advance.

While we recognize that the upcoming changes will be somewhat disruptive; we assure you, the final outcome will be improvements that you will be able to enjoy for years to come.


As with any construction project, some dust and noise are expected. If the noise becomes bothersome, please
